Discover the Bears, Carve a Memory: Only in Garrett County®

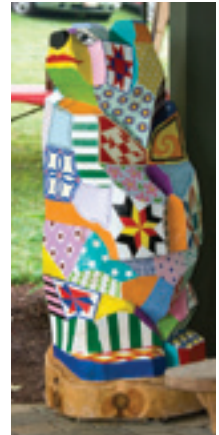
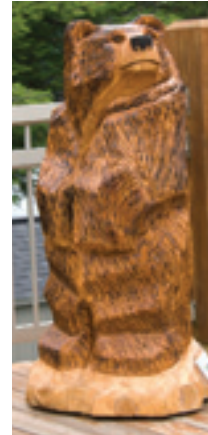
